# How to use this guide

This guide contains details of all artists and artist groups taking part. Each artist entry is listed according to which of the 14 North Norfolk areas they are in, which are marked on the map on pages 4-5.

This year we have over 170 artists taking part who each have a unique ID number. **From Saturday 23 May to Sunday 7 June** all studios are open from 10am-5pm unless otherwise stated.

Simply select which artist or artists you want to visit, check when they're open and make your visit. There's no need to book in advance unless you are a large group or would like to check the studio's accessibility.



### Accessibility

Studios with wheelchair and easy access are marked with the recognised wheelchair symbol. Further details of access can be found on our website.

Please remember that as most studios are private and not usually open to the public, it is unlikely you will have access to toilet facilities or wheelchair-accessible toilets. For any particular needs, we suggest phoning ahead to the studio you wish to visit.

### North Norfolk Studio areas

Each area has a more detailed map on its introduction page showing where each artist is located. This is followed by all the artists showing in that particular area, in numerical and alphabetical order.

### what3words

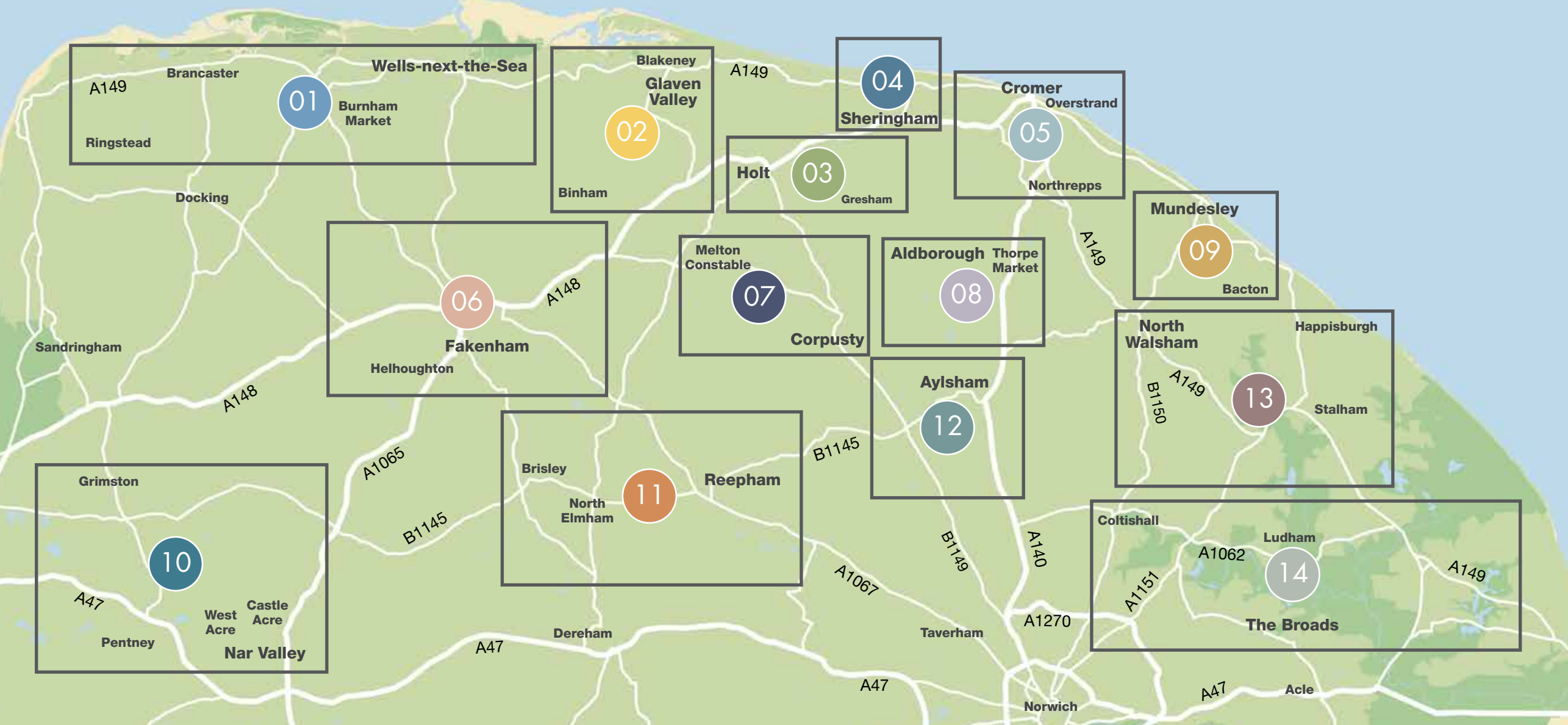

Welcome to the beautiful west North Norfolk coast. Stretching from peaceful Ringstead through to bustling Wells-next-the-Sea, this stunning stretch of coastline is a brilliant backdrop for 11 open studios. You'll find yourself inspired by the art, the rolling salt marshes and vast vistas.

There are 4 artists showing a mix of skills in the village hall next to Ringstead's Gin Trap Inn. And while you are in the village, while not visit The Garage Studio Art Gallery? As you travel east there's a studio stop at scenic Brancaster followed by Burnham Market, an affluent village where an Architect's practice has opened its doors.

Wells-next-the-Sea, a vibrant town with a picturesque harbour, has 5 open studios dotted around. Artists here show a mix of disciplines including ceramics, sculpture, painting, contemporary textile work and metalwork. And there's plenty of cafés to stop off for coffee.

In close by Wighton, visit the fabulous Alfred Cohen Museum opened in 2023 and do come back for the contemporary North Norfolk Exhibition Project (NNEP) from July 2, on for a month and established since 2000.

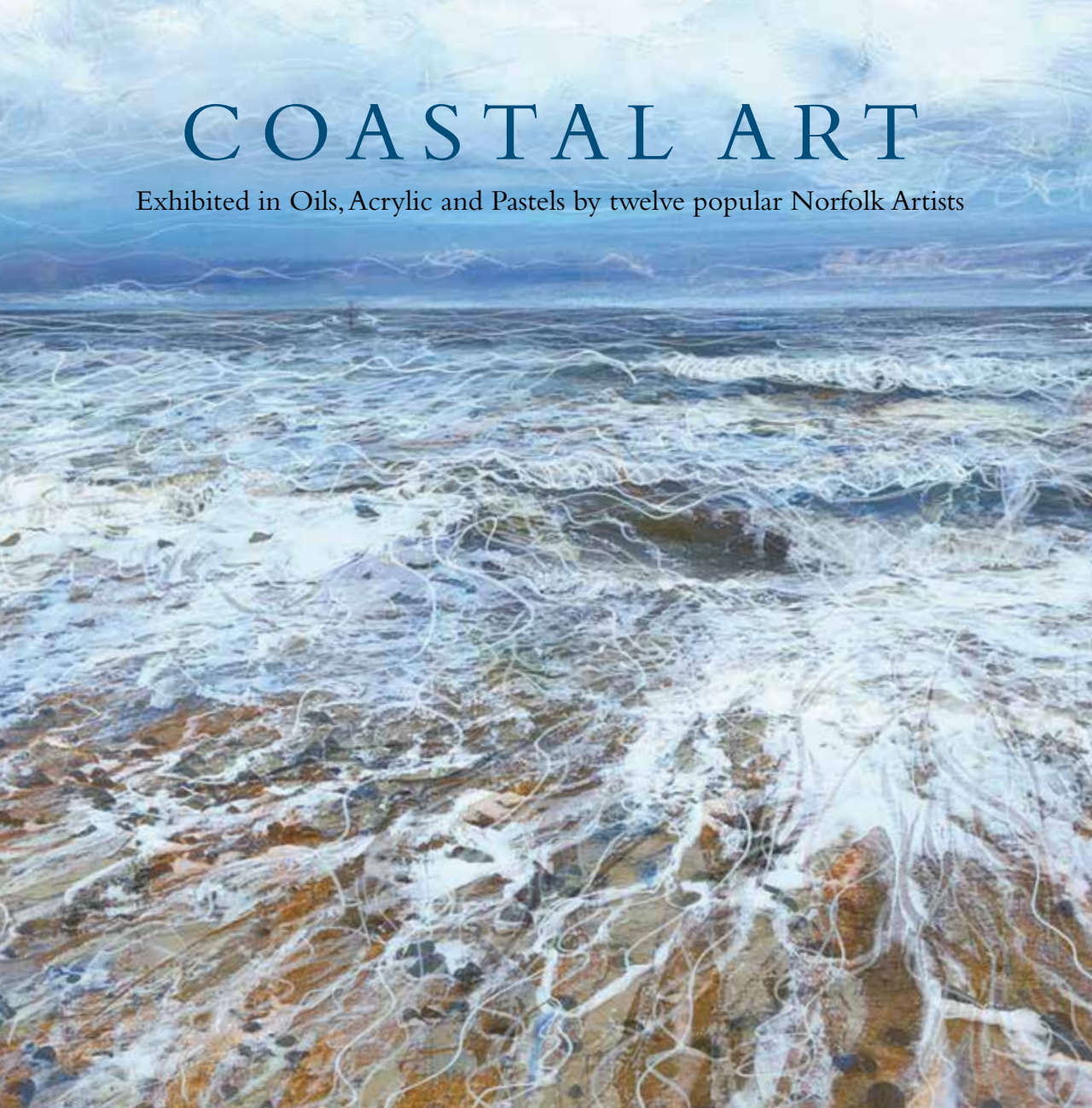

The Glaven Valley is a joy to explore. Rolling fields, meandering rivers and pretty villages like Stiffkey, Cley-next-the-Sea, Blakeney and Wiveton offer endless scenic nooks for a stroll or a photoshoot. There are 11 open studios to visit, offering a varied selection of arts.

If you pop into Glandford Barns to visit the Allen Hall Gallery, you'll find 3 other artists' studios open, along with shops and cafés. This is a stretch of coast and countryside shaped by wide skies, flint churches, creeks and marshes.

Alongside browsing art, there are some lovely walks in the area. Why not cross the marshes at Cley or Blakeney, walk along the River Glaven or try the Blakeney Freshes, a 5.6km trail specifically for viewing birds like marsh harrier or geese? With many pubs and cafés dotted throughout serving up hearty food, local ales and great coffee, this is a perfect area to explore.
